1:30p.m. 9-10 Year Old Girls & Boys combined (born 2012 & 2013) - 3000 Meters

2:00p.m. 11-12 year Old Girls & Boys combined (born 2010 & 2011) - 3000 Meters

2:30p.m. 13-14 Year Old Girls & Boys combined (born 2008 & 2009) - 4000 Meters

3:00p.m. 15-16 Year Old Girls & Boys (born 2004 & 2005) / 17-18 Year Old Women & Men (born 2003 & 2004), all combined - 5000 Meters

AGE DIVISION RULES: Age determined as of December 31, 2022

AWARDS: Medals for the top ten individuals in each age/gender division.

TEAMS: A team may have 5 to 8 competitors in the same age/gender division.

*The 15-16 and 17-18 year old age groups are combined for team scoring purposes.

The top 5 runners count in scoring for the team awards.
